

\*Hazleton Seniors Ride HPT for FREE – If you are 65 years of age and older, you can ride Hazleton Public transit free. All you need is your free HPT Transit ID card available from Hazleton Public Transit. Simply bring a photo ID or other proof of age to the HPT offices at 126 West Mine Street to fill out a short application form.

**\*\*Penn-State Hazleton Students** – Ride HPT FREE with your student ID to all your favorite Hazleton destinations. If you want to shop, dine, work or play, HPT is making life easier for you, too! Visit www.ridehpt.com for complete HPT service information.

\*\*\***Persons with Disability or Medicare cardholders** – Can ride any fixed route bus at reduced fare with a Reduced Fare card. The card can be obtained from the Hazleton Public Transit Office by completing a form and showing proof of disability or medicare coverage.

## **RIDER RULES AND INFORMATION**

**Animals** – Only trained guide and service animals assisting persons with disabilities are permitted on Hazleton Public Transit vehicles.

**Drinking/Eating** – Please refrain from consuming food and beverages of any kind while on board HPT vehicles. Closed beverage and food containers are permitted on board but may not be consumed while on the vehicle. Thank you for helping to keep our HPT buses clean for everyone!

**Headphones** – Passengers must use headphones when listening to portable electronic devices. Please keep the volume at a reasonable level to

#### WELCOME ABOARD HAZLETON PUBLIC TRANSIT

HPT operates bus service Monday through Sunday. Please check your desired travel route for specific arrival and departure times.

Hazleton Public Transit one-way bus fare is \$1.50. Operators and fareboxes cannot make change so we ask that you have the exact change ready when you ride HPT.

HPT passengers can connect between bus routes with the purchase of a transfer. Transfers cost \$0.50 and are useable for up to one (1) hour or until the arrival of the next available bus.

Hazleton Public Transit does not operate on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Easter Sunday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. In addition, HPT does not operate service the Sunday of Funfest.
